Advanced Setup for Windows Mail App

Windows Mail app is available with Windows 10 and 11

There are two ways you can access the advanced setup options for your email account:

1. Select **Advanced setup** from the error notification box if the automatic email setup fails.

2. On the Windows desktop, click the Start button (Windows icon) in the lower-left corner.

- Open the Mail app.
- Click the menu icon (3 bars) in the upper left corner to expand the menu.
- Click **Accounts** to open a sidebar menu on the right.
- Click **Add account** to open the Add an account menu.
- Select **Advanced setup** from the **Add an account** window.
- Choose **Internet email** account.

Enter the following information in the Advanced setup window:

- Email address: Enter your full email address (e.g., jsmith@fast-air.net).
- User name: Enter your full email address (e.g., jsmith@fast-air.net).
- **Password:** Enter the password associated with the email address.
- Account name: This is the name you'll see in the left pane of the Mail app under Accounts. You can choose any name you want.
- Send your messages using this name: Enter the name you want recipients to see when they receive a message from you (e.g., John Smith).
- Incoming email server: mail.fast-air.net
- Account type: IMAP4.
- Outgoing (SMTP) email server: mail.fast-air.net
- All four checkboxes at the bottom of the window should be selected.
- Click **Sign in** at the bottom of the dialog box.
- After several seconds, Windows will notify: **All done!** Click **Done** in the lower-right corner of the notice.
- The new account is in the left sidebar menu; click on it to open the Inbox.
